What kind of bike does my customer have?

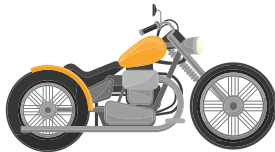

Cruiser

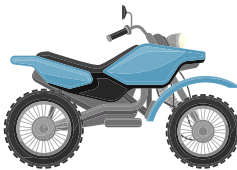
- Low seat

Scooter

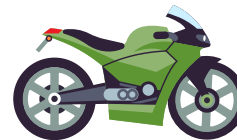
- Small wheels

- Step-through frame
- Floorboards

- Short handlebars
- Foot pegs below and behind seat

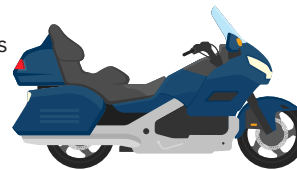
Includes supersport and sport trikes



Touring

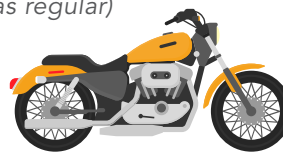
- Luggage compartments
- Navigation
- Emphasis on rider comfort and storage

Includes traditional trikes



Traditional (Also known as regular)

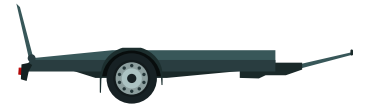
- Upright seating
- One or two passengers
- No spoilers or luggage compartments



On-road accessories:

Cargo trailer

- Pulled behind motorcycle



Transport trailer

- Pulled behind car
- For transport of motorcycle(s)
